- ❖ Take small bites, eat neatly, slowly with your mouth closed.

- ❖ Destroying the plants or plucking the flowers will spoil the beauty.
- ❖ Wait for your turn on swing and slides.

**Be Yourself:**

- ❖ Analyse yourself. List down improvement areas.

- ❖ Make an attempt to converse in English as much as possible.
- ❖ Assist in small household chores.
- ❖ Watch T.V only for limited hours. Select educative channels.

- ❖ Collect the leaves of different trees. Dry them & make a collage. Also write their names on them with coloured marker pens. Decorate your room with this collage.
- ❖ Worship the Sun God.

**Best out of Waste:**

**NOTE FOR PARENTS**
